ABOUT OSI-CAN

WE NEED YOUR HELP

Imagine ... The 911 call summoned police, fire, ambulance and other community first responders. The Canadian Armed Forces mobilized to a war-torn country or local disaster. These men and women, in Canada and abroad, found their own lives in danger; they witnessed death, destruction and desolation; they carried on to offer protection, help and solace. A single episode or sustained exposure to trauma can lead to Occupational Stress Injury (OSI, sometimes known as PTSD). OSI takes its toll with health and family breakdowns, and a rising number of suicides in military and community first responders. OSI-CAN can help.

I attend my first meeting and found out that I am not alone in the world and that other's experiences are much the same as mine. It really helps me to have a safe zone with others that feel the same and we are allowed to share feelings. For me to pay-it-forward I asked to become a peer support group leader. I successfully completed peer worker training, and now I am able to use my journey of growth to help others.

"I NEED YOUR HELP"

Imagine ... With those words, persons experiencing OSI can reach out to the OSI-CAN team and programs. They do not need a referral; they do not need to be diagnosed. This makes the Saskatchewan OSI-CAN program unique. Their recognition of their own need and willingness to ask for help can put them in touch with OSI peer support groups or family and friends of those with OSI supports groups (currently in Regina, Saskatoon, Tisdale, Prince Albert, North Battleford, Moose Jaw, Weyburn and Estevan), or our virtual support groups for individuals in hard-to-reach locations around the province. Partnerships with community-based service providers link clients with services necessary for their recovery, such as housing, counselling, vocational training, psychosocial rehabilitation, advice on prescriptions and equine therapy. We also provide referrals and assistance for the training and purchase of service dogs.

<u>OSI-CAN operates solely through private donations.</u> It costs approximately \$25,000 to purchase a service dog. A weekly drop-in meeting (rent, coffee, resources) costs about \$10 per person, or \$500/year. Counselling and other therapies can cost \$180 or more per session. Today we are asking for your sponsorship for the OSI-CAN Laughter Begins Recovery Comedy Night awareness and fundraising event.


